How the State’s Climate Office for Florida, we often receive questions about how to live with high humidity. Many people suffer from respiratory diseases or other health problems that are affected by moisture and are trying to find a suitable climate to move. The most common questions are: Is Florida the dampest state of the nation? Is there a part of Florida that is less humid than others? Before trying to answer these questions, it is better to have a brief discussion about how meteorologists measure and quantify moisture in the atmosphere. (Click on header to enlarge)
Relative humidity
Most people are familiar with moisture measurement as relative humidity. Simply put, relative humidity is the amount of water moisture or steam in the air compared to the maximum amount that air can contain at that temperature, or saturation. The saturation means that the air can no longer physically contain moisture as a water vapour, and that excess moisture condenses from the air in the form of dew or cloud drips. With 80% relative humidity, the air currently contains 80% of the water vapour that could retain if it was completely saturated at that temperature. The problem with the use of relative humidity is that hot air can contain much more water vapor than cold air. Then take a cold night in the north of Florida where you can wake up frost covering the ground. It happened that the air cooled to almost freeze and while the air cooled, it approached the saturation temperature for the amount of water vapor contained. So the relative humidity at that time approached 100%, but because it was so cold that the atmosphere did not contain much moisture and never felt wet or sticky. More or less similarly, relative humidity in Alaska can exceed 90% even if the temperature is below zero, but this is not comparable to the amount of humidity in the atmosphere during a hot day in Miami. Because relative humidity depends on the air temperature, it may vary considerably during the day according to the daytime cycle of the temperature. A typical summer day in Florida will have dew points around 70 degrees. Thus relative humidity will rise to more than 90% as the temperatures cool at night until the 70s, but then it will descend to 60% or less as the temperature rises above 90in the afternoon. Although we don’t like to use relative humidity, attached is an Excel spreadsheet that provides the average relative humidity of the early morning and afternoon for cities across the state of Florida. Dew point dew
Which leads us to a much better measurement of the moisture in the air, or the temperature of the dew point. The dew point temperature is a measure of the absolute amount of humidity in the air and is defined as the temperature that the air should be cooled to reach the saturation given the amount of water vapor present in the air. Thus, higher is the dew point, more water vapor in the atmosphere, regardless of temperature. Dew point temperatures are typically 65 to 75 during the summer in Florida, but it can be much less like the cold affects the northern part of the state during the winter. Which brings us back to the two questions ... the answer to this question is yes! With the Florida surrounded by the warm Gulf of Mexico and the Atlantic Ocean, and with the almost tropical climate of southern Florida, it is definitely the most wet state of the United States. Orlando with its theme parks and millions of visitors is not far away with dew points around 61 73. The map below shows the average dew points of July representative of the summer season. During the winter, North Florida and the Panhandle is much less humid than South Florida due to the coldest winter temperatures. Remember, the coldest air contains much less water vapor than the hot air, so the coldest areas of the Florida will be less humid than the most hot areas further south. The map below shows the average dew points of January representative of North Florida winter values and the panhandle have average dew points of 40 to 50 and south of Florida has 55 or higher winter dew points. "Boy, today it’s hot and wet ... there must be 95 degrees outside with 95% of humidity." How many times have we heard this sentence or something similar to pronounce during a hot day? Even if there was a day with a temperature of 95 and a dew point of 80, yes only a relative humidity of 62%. Remember that hot air can contain much more water vapor than colder air. The human body (and some animals) cools by secreting sweat, which cools while evaporating due to evaporative cooling. This process is much more effective in dry climates, where sweat evaporates faster. Higher humidity means less evaporation and less cooling. We have a quantity known as the "heat index" that combines the effects of high temperatures and humidity and is used for thermal stress warnings.
